## ORDER GRANTING COMPLEX CHAPTER 11 BANKRUPTCY CASE TREATMENT

This case was filed on May 1, 2020. A Notice of Designation as Complex Chapter 11 Case was filed. [ECF Doc. 2]. Based on its review of the initial pleadings, the Court concludes that the complex chapter 11 case designation is appropriate. Accordingly,

**IT IS ORDERED** that the Procedures for Complex Chapter 11 Cases in the Eastern District of Louisiana (the "<u>Procedures</u>") apply to this case. The Procedures are posted on the Court's website, <a href="https://www.laeb.uscourts.gov/">https://www.laeb.uscourts.gov/</a>. Compliance with the Procedures is required;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Debtor must give notice of this Order to all parties in interest within seven (7) days. If a party-in-interest objects to the provisions of this Order, that party may file an appropriate motion within fourteen (14) days after service of this Order;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Local Rules for the Eastern District of Louisiana Bankruptcy Court apply to this case, unless otherwise ordered by the Court. If a conflict exists between the Local Bankruptcy Rules and the Procedures, the Procedures govern; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that movant shall within seven (7) days serve a copy of this Order on all parties in interest who will not receive notice through the ECF System pursuant

to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and the Local Rules Bankruptcy Rules and file a certificate of service to that effect within three (3) days.
