2. <u>Administrative Procedures Manual</u>

In conjunction with the rewriting of the local rules, the administrative procedures were removed from the local rules and are now included in the *Administrative Procedures Manual*.

The procedures for Section A and Section B have also been compiled into separate procedures manuals for each section of the Court.

3. Motions to Expedite / Expedited Hearings

To obtain a date for expedited hearing, counsel should: (1) file the underlying motion, (2) file the motion for expedited hearing; and (3) submit via email, the proposed order with blank date for the hearing.

The court will determine if the request to expedite will be granted. If the motion to expedite is granted, the order will provide the date for the hearing and state that counsel is to serve the order and file a certificate of service. Upon docketing of the order, the case administrator will set the matter for hearing on the Court's calendar.

See Proposed Local Rule 9013-1(C)("Any party requesting an expedited hearing must contact chambers.")

4. Redacting Private Information

All filings must be redacted according to FRBP 9037 and the Administrative Procedures Manual, Rule 11.

A sample motion and order to redact has recently been posted on the website at www.laeb.uscourts.gov, under "Forms and Publications". (See attached).

When filing the motion to redact, be sure to attach the redacted document, and include language in the proposed order that instructs the Clerk to substitute the redacted document for the one already filed in the record.

5. <u>Multi-Court Voice Case Information System (McVCIS)</u>

The Court has recently upgraded its automated "dial-in" case information system to the new Multi-Court Voice Case Information System. The McVCIS direct dial toll-free number is 866-222-8029.

McVCIS is an interactive voice response system that is designed to handle multiple courts. Customers are first prompted to identify the court, then they may get case information by using the phone's keypad or the new voice recognition software. Search by name, case number, or social security number. Available information includes case name, date of filing, chapter, debtor's attorney, trustee, date and time of pending 341 meeting, date of discharge, closing date, and general case status.
